Hidden away on the edge of the Yorkshire dales is Dalesbank Holiday Park. A true 'gateway to the Dales,' the holiday park is an ideal base for exploring the surrounding areas which include West Yorkshire, Bronte Country, Haworth and the acres of industrial heritage in the wool towns at Skipton and beyond.

The park itself was formerly a working farm, but thirty years ago its owner Meadmore Preston decided to change the farm's fortune and create the holiday park as it's known today. Meadmore himself is a real character and has been working the site for the last 56 years, offering a traditional Yorkshire welcome to all. The park is set in 20 acres of beautiful rolling Yorkshire countryside, and beyond its boundaries are another 100 acres of unspoilt land. Within the park, there are outstanding facilities for bed and breakfast, caravan and camping, with a function room and restaurant/bar also available.

Dalesbank Lodge is home to the park's bed and breakfast accommodation. It encompasses five family sized rooms, each with an en suite bathroom and shower, and a further selection of rooms sleeping between 3-6 people in a variety of twin style and double rooms. Meadmore also offers one suite fully adapted for disabled customers, also with its own en suite bathroom. Each room is spacious with glorious views across the countryside, being set within the farm's old barn.

The caravan and campsite offers pitches for touring, static and motor homes, with ample winter storage and tent facilities also. The site opens from Easter to October, and encompasses electric hook ups and access to a shower and toilet block. In the summer months the large games area is a hive of activity; families and children playing alike.

Guests of both the bed and breakfast and the campsite are welcomed to use the park's restaurant and bar; 'Meadmore's Restaurant.' It's best known for its Sunday lunch, served from 12-2pm on a bookings only basis. Throughout the rest of the week the menu remains traditional with plenty of classic Yorkshire fayre, all deliciously cooked in a farmhouse style. The bar opens on demand, but is always stocked with a good choice of real ales, lagers, spirits and wines. The Clubhouse is also able to hold functions with up to 200 guests, complete with dance floor and traditional catering options, including a magnificent hog roast.

For a real taste of the countryside, and all the friendly charm that goes with it; visit Meadmore and his beloved park.
