08/05346/cou	1-3 St. Johns Street	formation of 3 self contained flats.	Objection on grounds of grave highway concerns, no parking facilities are to be offered at all which will cause an additional strain on highways as exiting ground floor shop already causing hazards with deliveries, more traffic into this complicated and dangerous junction will aggravate the situation even more. There is no allocated bin storage space for the 3 flats. The council also feel that this is also a case of overdevelopment of the property as it was never residential. No request for panel was made and council understand this item could now be decided by officer delegation.
