### SILSDEN TOWN HALL

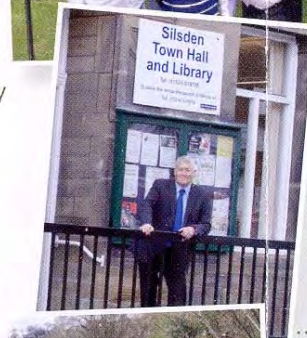

## SUPPORTING OUR COMMUNITY

Local Conservatives have slammed Labour run Bradford Council's plan to build more houses on green field sites in Steeton, Silsden and Addingham.

The Conservative candidate in May's local elections, Andrew Rowley, has called on Bradford Council to look again at brown field and bring more empty homes back into use.

"I am not opposed to building new affordable housing but our green belt land should not be used when there are brown field sites available. There seems to be a build now think later mentality to this process with no thought for a supporting infrastructure" He said.

Andrew vowed to defend the greenbelt if he's elected to the council "we can't continue to build without thinking about the bigger picture" adding "I will do everything I can to save our green belt from Labour's over development."



Conservative campaigner Andrew Rowley is fighting to clean up our streets by tackling the problem of dog fouling.

"Dog fouling is fast becoming a major problem which needs to be addressed. On the whole responsible dog owners do clean up after their dogs but I'm determined to make sure that everyone plays by the rules and keeps our streets safe and clean."
